

#### A Note from Fr. Paul Fagan

Dear Friends,

Today is Sat. 08 May 2021. I am writing to you from Prairie du Chien to let you know that after 9 months here in Wisconsin I am planning to fly out of Chicago on Tuesday 11 May returning to my parish of St. Peter in Nkololo and to Songambele Hospital. I have enjoyed the new life and freshness of Spring for the first time in 60 years. If I am well and able I will return for a visit in the summer of 2022. Some of you know that I was sick with Covid 19 a few days before my planned departure on 18 Nov. 2020. I was seriously ill and admitted to Crossing Rivers Hospital in Prairie du Chien for 15 days. Due to excellent care and the fervent prayers of many people I survived and am recovering. I trust in God that I will be able to make the long trip back home and that I will be able to meet the requirements for travel as well as entry into Tanzania. It will be a challenge. I am anxious to get back to my parish and to my assignment as chaplain of Songambele Hospital. I am happy to say that during my absence the administration really did an excellent job of moving forward with reconstruction and passing the many inspections from health officials. It is time for me to get back to work. My prayers for you all and please remember me in your prayers.
