Hello from Mr. Lechnir, Middle School Religion teacher at Prairie Catholic.

I am blessed with a fabulous group of students in grades 5 through 8. We have covered a lot of ground already in the first six weeks of this school year. We've learned some basics such as, "Why did God make us?"
