The celebration of the triduum will be celebrated at St. Gabriel this year: Holy Thursday Mass will be at 7:00 PM, Good Friday service at 12:15 PM, and the Easter Vigil at 8:30 PM. The Easter Sunday Masses will be 8:00 AM at St. Gabriel, and 10:00 AM at St. John.
