### September 17, 2023 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The annual Mass with the anointing of the sick will be Tuesday, October 10th, 8:30 AM at St. Gabriel Church. This sacrament is given to Catholics who are preparing for major surgery, the seriously ill, the aging, and the dying. When entering the church that morning, please follow the directions where to be seated.

Wisconsin Safe Haven Laws allow parents to relinquish an infant under 72 hours old to any first responder, no questions asked. Those first responders could be police officers, 911 emergency medical staff, or hospital staff members. You do not have to give your name or address to the professional accepting the baby unless the baby has been harmed, someone is forcing the parent to give up the baby, or the baby is more than 3 days old. The parent may be asked if they are willing to fill out a form, but it is NOT required; however, it will help providers give the infant the best care. If you wish to learn more about this law,
